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Foundation Statement

The foundation of Christ Classical Academy is the Word of God. The government of Christ Classical Academy is subject to the Board of Directors. Moreover, this organization is committed to the following educational principles:

1. Christian education has its foundation in the Creator-creature relationship taught in the scriptures (Col. 1:15-17). It is understood as a process wherein a child's personality is formed by instruction in the truth of God and human knowledge leavened with the truth.
2. The responsibility for education rests upon the parents (Deut. 6:6-9; Eph. 6:1-4). They may delegate a part of this responsibility to an institution which is able to carry forward their God given task. The authority of the teacher in discipline and character training is derived from the fact that he stands on behalf of the parents; and the teacher derives authority in subject matter from faithfulness to the laws of God revealed in His Word and creation.
3. The child is first of all a spiritual-physical being, created in the image of God, capable of and responsible for learning, knowing and obeying the truth of God's Word and the laws of His creation. He is at the same time a social being standing in relation to his fellow man, having moral, intellectual, and emotional needs.
4. The curriculum of the Christian school is the medium through which the child is oriented to a life in Christ and to the culture of this world for fellowship with and service to God in this life and the life to come.
