School Bus Code of Conduct

The 1995 National Standards of School Buses and National Standards for School Bus Operation contain 17 suggested rules for safe student transportation.

To ensure safe student transportation, the student shall:

1. Follow directions of the driver the first time given.
2. Arrive at the bus stop before the bus arrives.
3. Wait in a safe place, clear of traffic and away from where the bus stops.
4. Wait in an orderly line and avoid horseplay.
5. Cross the road or street in front of the bus only after the bus has come to a complete stop and upon the direction of the driver.
6. Go directly to an available or assigned seat when entering the bus.
7. Remain seated and keep the aisles and exits clear.
8. Refrain from throwing or passing objects on, from, or into the bus.
9. Refrain from carrying hazardous materials, nuisance items, and animals onto the bus.
10. Respect the rights and safety of others.
11. Refrain from drinking and eating on the bus.
12. Refrain from leaving or boarding the bus at locations other than the assigned stops at home or school.
13. Refrain from extending head, arm, or objects out of the bus window.
14. Keep your hands and feet to your self and maintain an inside voice while in the bus.
